Photo Day Logistics - Rather than a production line approach, we aim to create an experience for the students to enjoy. We know school pictures can be intimidating for some of the kids and our goal is to help students forget they are in front of a camera and just have fun. Our approach requires a little more time - we spend roughly 1 minute with each student in the younger grades and ~30 seconds each with the older kids (who are often more comfortable and can move through quicker). That time allows us to capture multiple photos for each student (galleries are typically 15-20+ images) with a variety of expressions - this is all done with the intention of seeing a genuine smile or two somewhere in the mix.

In past years the extended time with each student forced us to split larger schools over a couple days but this upcoming year we have brought on another photographer (Michelle) so we will be running two concurrent setups (a note that we'll require the gym for space) so all the students will all be captured in a single day.

Retakes are done approximately two weeks following our original visit. We provide an online form for retakes requests - families can provide details which helps us understand what they would like to see adjusted from the original photo session. Retake day is also used to capture any students that were away on the original date.

Products and Purchasing

We offer both digital and printed products. I'm just finalizing this upcoming year's pricing (based on what increases our printers are passing along). They shouldn't be much different from last year.

Our digital downloads are available as individual images (\$15 per image) or as a full gallery (\$45 for the full gallery of all images captured).

Purchased digital images are high resolution for prints up to 10x13" and free of all watermarks.

The digital downloads are the most flexible option as they can easily be shared online or printed/sent to any lab or online printing service (e.g., Costco, London Drugs, ABC Photo - professional lab) and with no restrictions (images are royalty free).

For families that prefer to order prints, we will have a couple of different packages as well as individual sheets. Examples -

Small print package (one pose) - 8 wallets and two 5x7s - \$29

Large print package (one pose) - 8 wallets, two 5x7s, four 3x5s, and one 8x10 - \$45

Individual sheets - one 8x10, two 5x7s (one pose per sheet) - \$20

We also have options to combine print + digital packages:

Small print package + full gallery download - \$65

Large print package + full gallery download - \$75

And, this year we'll also be trying items like mugs and keychains. Backgrounds As you will see in our examples, we capture all our portraits on a seamless white background. We use this same set up for actor headshots, athletes portraits, and business professional headshots. It provides a clean image that focuses all the attention on the subject. It also allows for the option of full length photos (standing poses). These are especially useful for the youngest students that prefer to not sit still. Sometimes a spin or jump is the perfect solution to distract from the fact they are being photographed and we capture both a true smile and an action shot! The white (unlike a greenscreen) gives us that flexibility for the full body images but it does make it difficult to "cut out" the subject and offer background alternatives. Families are welcome to download the digital files and do this on their own (this technology is advancing quickly) OR we can provide the service for an additional fee (\$15 per image) for the knockout. This is something we are testing out this year - I haven't finalized all the details yet - but because we take so many images per student, we are not able to include this for every photo unfortunately.
